- Commission to **continue developing policy and awareness-raising initiatives** at the global level on accelerating the implementation of the **Sustainable Development Goals**, including **Goal 16**
- Commission to encourage **Member States presenting VNRs at the HLPF** to share their experiences, progress made, challenges and impediments in implementing those aspects of the 2030 Agenda that are related to the work of the Commission;
- Member States to consider including **information related to the work of the Commission, including on the implementation of SDG 16**, in their VNRs for 2024.

Resolution: 15th United Nations Crime Congress

United Arab Emirates, 2026

- Theme: “Accelerating crime prevention, criminal justice and the rule of law: protecting people and planet and achieving the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development in the digital age”
- During its recent 32nd session, the Commission negotiated and recommended for adoption by the General Assembly a comprehensive and forward-looking substantive agenda for the 15th UN Crime Congress

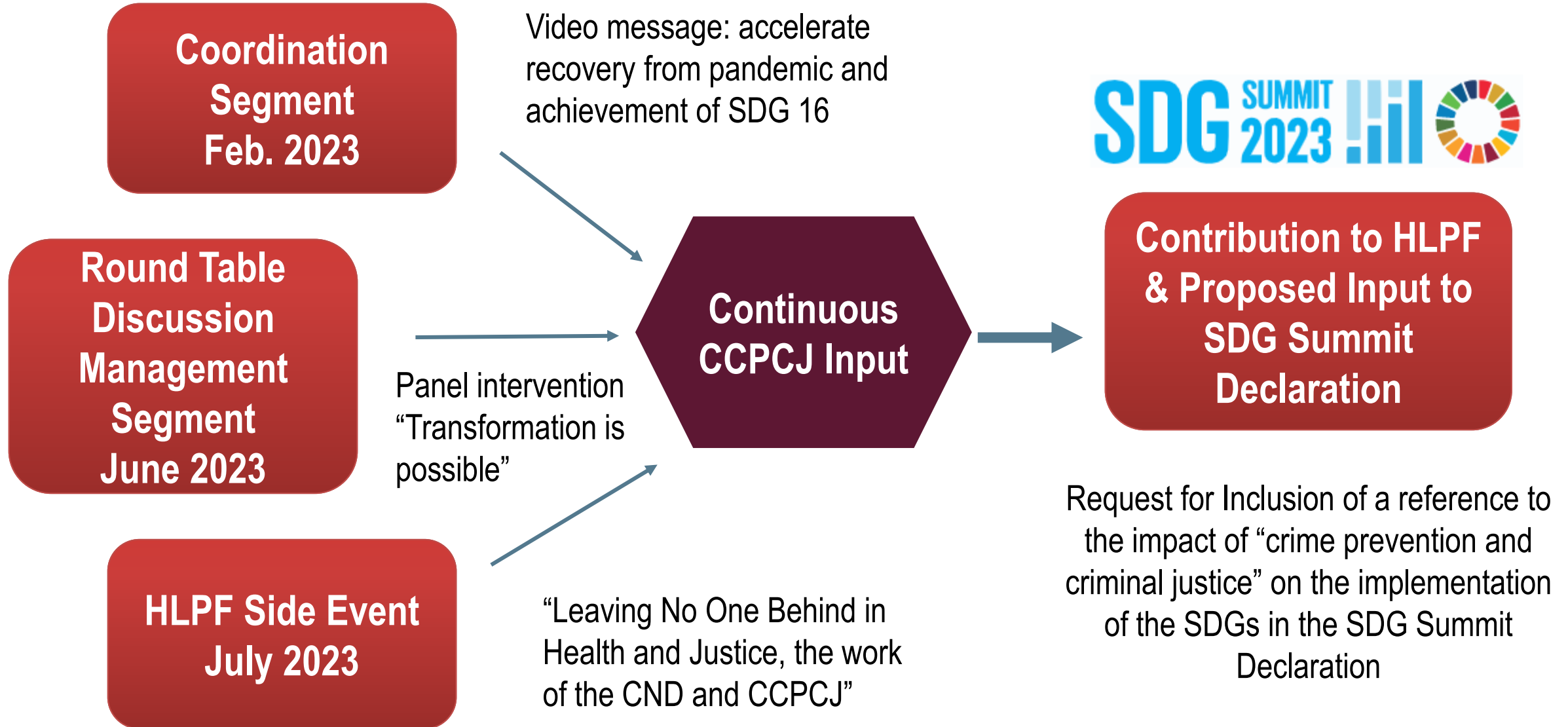

ON THE ROAD TO THE SDG SUMMIT



ECOSOC Recommendations already implemented by CCPCJ:

- ✓ **Theme alignment** – Specific, focused and well delineated themes aligned with ECOSOC themes
- ✓ **Expertise and policy recommendations** on global challenges such as the COVID-19 recovery, climate change and poverty eradication.
- ✓ **Cooperation among functional commissions** – CND, CSD, CSW, Statistical Commission, Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues
- ✓ **Dedicated agenda item**
- ✓ **Consensus-based approaches**



Areas of increased engagement by CCPCJ since ECOSOC Recommendations:

- **Leaving no one behind: Disability inclusion** – invitations to regular session and website aligned with disability inclusion principles
- Consider the impact of **long-term trends, such as demographic trends**: Strengthening work with youth, youth participation in the opening of the thematic discussions; exploring work with older persons
- **Inclusion of VNRs** – see above resolution “Enhancing the contributions of the CCPCJ to the accelerated implementation of the 2030 Agenda”
