Funding

- The meeting ***will not*** entail implications for the regular budget. It will be supported through extra-budgetary resources, with the support of the Government of Chile, the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC), and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).
- Travel funding will be available to ***one high-level representative*** of 2024 ECOSOC Member States from ***LDCs, LLDCs, and SIDS, as well as from developing countries, on a case-by-case basis***. The funding will cover economy-class round-trip air tickets and accommodation.
- The process for the selection of representatives and the provision of travel support ***will be communicated to those who have registered*** to participate in the meeting and indicated their request for eligible funding in the registration form.
