Conversation with Executive Secretaries of regional commissions and Chairs of functional commissions and expert bodies on sustainable, resilient and innovative solutions to accelerate the implementation of the 2030 Agenda

In relation to the 2024 main theme of ECOSOC and the HLPF, the Executive Secretaries of regional commissions could kick-off the dialogue by providing a preview of what is coming up at the regional forums on sustainable development and highlighting innovative initiatives to accelerate the implementation of the 2030 Agenda being carried out at the regional level. The panel would continue with highlights of the work of ECOSOC functional commissions and expert bodies and policy recommendations to accelerate the SDGs provided by their respective Chairs in an interactive exchange among them and with Member States. Collaborative initiatives among subsidiary bodies and with UN entities will also be highlighted. The session will give priority to the subsidiary bodies that are not featured in other parts of the programme to highlight their work.

Member States are invited to (i) reflect on the work of ECOSOC subsidiary bodies and proposals from the informal note prepared by the Secretariat, and (ii) provide action-oriented and forward-looking policy guidance to ensure coherence and direction in the policies and





normative work of subsidiary bodies and UN system entities, including specialized agencies, relating to the acceleration of the implementation of the 2030 Agenda.
