How to explain the QCPR to a primary school child?

Countries team up to tell parts of the UN what to do to help solve big problems like poverty, hunger, and unfairness. They write these instructions in a document and check every year to see if it's working.

And the translation:

Countries team up to tell parts of the UN (UNDS) what to do to help solve big problems like poverty, hunger, and unfairness (OAD). They write these instructions in a document (the QCPR) and check every year to see if it's working (ECOSOC OAS and the General Assembly).



What is Operational Activities for Development (OAD) and who is the UN development system (UNDS)?

What is OAD?

Operational Activities for Development (OAD) are UN development activities delivered to <u>162 countries and territories</u> to support the 2030 Agenda and achieve the SDGs.

What is the UNDS?

The **UN development system (UNDS)** includes all UN entities conducting operational activities for development (OAD).



How much was spent on OAD in 2023 (USD)?

\$51.3 billion UNDS OAD (75% of all UN spending)

\$20.5 billion in Development assistance \$30.8 billion in Humanitarian assistance



What is the <u>UN Sustainable Development Group</u>?

Nations

Social Affairs

- The <u>UNSDG</u> is the internal UN strategic coordination and policy mechanism for the UN development system.
- Chaired by the Deputy Secretary-General, it includes 38 entities



What is the QCPR? (A/RES/79/226)

- General Assembly resolution <u>79/226</u> titled "Quadrennial comprehensive policy review of operational activities for development of the United Nations system"
 - Since 1969, quadrennial from 2012, next review 2028
 - Strategic guidance to the whole UN development system.
 - System-wide policy for country level cooperation
 - Assess effectiveness, efficiency, coherence & impact



Key issues for the 2024 QCPR

- Improving support to countries through the resident coordinator system, UN country teams, regional and global integrated policy support and business operations
- Improving **policy actions and tools**, for better UN collective support and configuration, delivering more effective tailored support to country situations and to leave no one behind
- Scaling up means of implementation through financing for development, partnerships, science, technology and innovation, including digital and data systems.
- Fortifying UNDS accountability and oversight including funding

ECOSOC OAS structure and outcome

Structure:

- **Day 1**: PR-level interactive dialogues with the Secretary-General and Deputy Secretary-General on their reports and the UNDS.
- **Days 2 & 3**: Interactive sessions with high-level UNDS & experts on UNDS policy, performance, challenges, and priorities.

Outcome:

- Non-negotiated Chair's Summary,
- ECOSOC may adopt a <u>resolution</u> after the Segment
