Establishment of a Multidisciplinary Expert Panel under the auspices of the CND




Composition of the Panel

- 10 experts selected by the CND (2 experts per Regional Group)
- **5 experts** nominated by the UN Secretary-General
- 3 experts by the INCB, 1 expert by the DG of WHO
- Two Co-Chairs: one selected by the CND, one appointed by the Secretary-General

Mandate of the Panel

 Develop recommendations to strengthen the work of the CND, as well as to enhance the implementation of the obligations of the international drug control conventions, and relevant international instruments, and the achievement of all international drug policy commitments, with a view to contribute to the 2029 review



- The **Extended Bureau & Regional Groups** currently discussing implementation modalities including the required XB resources.
- UNODC to serve as **Secretariat** to the panel.
- Progress report at the 69th session; recommendations to be discussed at the 70th session.
