United Nations to identify transformative policies and actions for accelerated COVID-19 recovery and advancing global goals.

WHAT United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) Coordination Segment

The United Nations will come together to mobilize action for an accelerated recovery from the pandemic guided by the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) at the UN ECOSOC Coordination Segment. The Segment will feature Chairs of ECOSOC functional commissions and expert bodies, Executive Secretaries of the regional commissions, and Heads of UN system entities, including specialized agencies.

The Coordination Segment will address the main annual theme: "Accelerating the recovery from the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) and the full implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development at all levels" and provide forward-looking policy guidance towards the high-level segment of ECOSOC and the High-level Political Forum (HLPF) in July.

Building on the knowledge and work of the ECOSOC system, the Economic and Social Council will identify transformative policies and actions that could be put in place to accelerate the achievement of the SDGs. The policy findings and recommendations coming out of the Coordination Segment will contribute to the 2023 SDG Summit, as well as other major upcoming events in 2023.
