Second, we need to make advances in STI policy coherence that greatly accelerates technology transfer, diffusion and innovation, in a manner that is commensurate with the SDGs.

Third, technology roadmaps and action plans are needed.

They could be a means to allow all interested stakeholders to work together for the SDGs.

Fourth, we need to make major efforts to support "social technologies", which are critical for changing the mindsets and



the behaviours. Social technologies are also critical to reach those left behind.

Finally, the future STI Forums should work cumulatively, learning and advancing on the achievements of previous Forums. For this, we should explore various options, such as inter-sessional events and activities or an annual programme of work.

I encourage all of you to think of how we can further enhance the Forum and make it best contribute to the implementation of the SDGs.
