

# Leveraging ECOSOC for an inclusive and resilient recovery guided by the 2030 Agenda

## Roundtable Discussion during Management Segment 9 June 2022 10:00 – 12:00 (NY Time)

During the ECOSOC Management Segment in June 2022, the Economic and Social Council will convene a discussion to integrate key messages from ECOSOC subsidiary bodies and the UN system on the Council's main theme, develop action-oriented recommendations for follow-up and feed into the high-level political forum on sustainable development (as mandated by GA resolution 75/290 A). To this end, the Council will:

- Build on the key messages of the 2022 ECOSOC Coordination Segment;
- Elaborate on the recent outcomes of the <u>ECOSOC functional commissions and expert</u> bodies, as well as intergovernmental bodies of the UN entities; and
- Highlight the key messages from the contributions of the ECOSOC system to the main theme of ECOSOC and HLPF.

The <u>2022 ECOSOC Coordination Segment</u> took stock of the major impacts of the pandemic on the SDGs. It covered a wide range of policies and actions for an inclusive and resilient recovery aimed at the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. Member States underscored the importance of ECOSOC, its functional commissions and expert bodies in responding to COVID-19 and promoting a sustainable and balanced recovery from COVID-19. The Segment identified key areas where ECOSOC, its subsidiary bodies and the UN system could deepen the policy reflection, identify innovative solutions or work more closely together. <u>A non-negotiated factual summary</u> has been prepared in consultation with the Bureau of the Council to reflect discussions during the partnership forum and the coordination segment and the strategic proposals made during the coordination segment, as mandated by GA resolution 75/290 A.

#### **Format**

The Council will convene a roundtable discussion on 9 June 2022 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. in the ECOSOC Chamber. The discussion will be chaired by H.E. Ambassador Ms. Lachezara Stoeva (Bulgaria), in charge of the ECOSOC Management Segment, and moderated by H.E. Ambassador Mr. Suriya Chindawongse (Thailand), in charge of the 2022 Coordination Segment. The roundtable participants will include Chairs of ECOSOC subsidiary bodies and Heads of UN system entities.

### **Background documents**

As mandated by GA <u>resolution 75/290 A</u>, this discussion during the Management Segment will be "informed by the existing <u>report of the Secretary-General synthesizing the inputs of the functional commissions of the Council and other intergovernmental bodies and forums to the <u>thematic review of the high-level political forum</u>". Furthermore, the <u>summary</u> of the <u>2022 ECOSOC Coordination Segment</u> and the <u>inputs</u> of <u>ECOSOC subsidiary bodies</u> to the HLPF will inform the discussions at the roundtable.</u>

#### Outcome

The outcome of this discussion will be a summary with key messages and recommendations.
