As countries start to implement the 2030 Agenda, a number of challenges are emerging at this crucial stage. <u>Southern Voice</u>, a network of 49 think tanks from Africa, Asia and Latin America is currently working to examine national experiences in meeting the early challenges of delivering the 2030 Agenda. Issues examined include SDG integration, institutional arrangements, resource availability, data challenges and participation in the country context.

This side event will bring together leading think tank researchers from the *Southern Voice* network to share their findings and recommendations on taking a holistic approach to the 2030 Agenda, and inform a discussion among UN mission, international organizations, academic and civil society representatives in New York.
