Japan is a strong supporter of the UN Development System reform effort led by the

Secretary-General, with the aim to enhance the efficiency, effectiveness, and coherence of the

UNDS on the ground.

Successful reform requires the collective efforts of the whole UNDS. In this regard, Japan

commends the tremendous efforts by each agency to ensure the smooth implementation of the

reinvigorated Resident Coordinator System, including cost-sharing, administration of the 1%

levy, and harmonization of procedures through the roll-out of the UNCT Business Operation

Strategies.

While we are pleased to hear that 92% of Governments responded that the RCs ensured a

coherent UN response to the pandemic, it is concerning that when it comes to the UNSDG's

commitment to the Funding Compact, some indicators, including "improved focus on common

results among UNSDGs at the country level", had gone down compared to the baseline year.

As pointed out in the Secretary-General's report, continued efforts are required for a

fundamental realignment and culture change within UN entities.

In order to address the multidimensional causes and consequences of complex challenges,

and to take people-centered, comprehensive, context-specific, and prevention-oriented

approaches based on the concept of human security, we wish to see more examples of effective

coordination among UN entities.

In order for UNCTs to work together in support of national development priorities toward

achieving the SDGs, it is imperative to avoid duplication and leverage the comparative

advantages of each agency under the guidance of Sustainable Development Cooperation

Framework, including Common Country Analysis.

I count on your leadership to further enhance UNCTs to take a "One-UN approach"

toward maximum development results in each program country.
