PATTERN OF CONFERENCES

Note by the Secretary-General

The Economic and Social Council, at its 998th meeting on 13 December 1957, in the course of which it worked out its basic programme for 1958, decided that it would consider at its twenty-sixth session, resolution 1202 (XII) on the pattern of conferences, adopted by the General Assembly on the same date. The Council decided to consider the resolution in connexion with its general review of the development and co-ordination of the economic, social and human rights programmes and activities of the United Nations and the specialized agencies as a whole, and also in connexion with the question of the calendar of conferences for 1959.

The Council further decided to transmit the resolution to its subsidiary organs, calling their attention in particular to paragraph 5.

The text of the resolution has been issued in document A/RES/1202 (XII) of 14 December 1957.
