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THE STANDARD INTERNATIONAL TRADE CLASSIFICATION
AND THE 1955 BRUSSELS TARIFF NOMENCLATURE

Proposal for Combining the Two Systems

(Memorandum by the Secretary General)

1. On the advice of the Statistical Commission, the Economic and Social Council on 12 July 1950 promulgated the SITC by means of the following resolution^{1/}:

"The Economic and Social Council

"Taking note of the work done by the Statistical Commission during its third, fourth and fifth sessions, and the comments received from Governments and specialized agencies regarding the Standard International Trade Classification, and

"Taking note that the classification recommended can serve as a basis for the reporting of trade statistics to international agencies, thus reducing the burden on Governments;

"Urges all Governments to make use of this Standard Classification by:

"(i) Adopting this system of Classification with such modifications as may be necessary to meet national requirements, without disturbing the framework of the classification, or

"(ii) Re-arranging their statistical data in accordance with this system for purposes of international comparison."

2. Governments of countries accounting for about 80 per cent of world trade now regularly compile trade-by-commodity data according to the SITC and the major international agencies have adopted the SITC as a basis for the reporting of trade statistics. In addition, a number of countries also use the SITC as the basis of their customs nomenclature.^{2/} The traditional method, however, of providing the precise definitions used for customs purposes is to group articles according to the nature of the material of which they are made and most customs nomenclatures not based on the SITC follow this method. The result of the use of this method is that data obtained from the customs declarations have had traditionally to be regrouped in order to provide economic statistics, which are primarily based on grouping by degree of fabrication and by industrial origin.

3. Shortly after the second World War, a European Customs Union Study Group was formed with headquarters in Brussels. In 1950 it promulgated a tariff nomenclature, along traditional lines, designed to be used in common by the European countries. The second edition of the SITC contains a key between that nomenclature (subdivided where necessary) and the SITC. By 1955 the Study Group had become the Customs Cooperation Council, which promulgated a Tariff Nomenclature^{3/} here referred to as the BTN (Brussels Tariff Nomenclature), based on the nomenclature devised by the Study Group but incorporating some revisions. The BTN is now widely used in Europe.

4. Countries outside Europe much of whose trade is with Europe are taking an interest in the BTN and some have adopted it. A detailed key between the SITC and the BTN has been worked out by the Scandinavian

countries^{4/}. It necessarily involves numerous subdivisions of BTN items, many of which are not, in themselves, meaningful. Considerable statistical resources are therefore required to regroup, into the form of the SITC, customs data collected according to the BTN. This situation poses serious inconveniences to the developed countries and practically insuperable obstacles to the countries whose statistical resources are seriously limited when they attempt to use both the SITC and the BTN.

5. The secretariats of a number of interested international agencies began, in the summer of 1958, to try to find a way of simplifying the relation between the SITC and the BTN without essentially altering the nature of either. The agencies are: the United Nations (principally through the Statistical Office of the United Nations and the secretariats of the Regional Economic Commissions), the Customs Cooperation Council, the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, the Organization for European Economic Cooperation, the European Economic Community (principally through the Statistical Office of the European Communities) and the Pan American Union (through the Inter American Statistical Institute). The Customs Cooperation Council generously encouraged the effort, the principles on which the SITC-BTN III is based were developed by a Statistical Working Party convened by the Council.

6. On 2nd December 1959 the draft correlation code, hereto attached, with the provisional title SITC-BTN III, was submitted to the Customs Cooperation Council. In order that the Statistical Commission might, at its eleventh session, know its views, the Council unanimously approved the broad lines of the draft SITC-BTN III and agreed to:

- (a) distinguish sub-headings in the Brussels Nomenclature as required by the SITC-BTN III and recommend that its members incorporate these either in their legal tariffs or in their national statistical nomenclatures;

(b) provide a commentary on these sub-headings in the Brussels Explanatory Notes,

(c) insert the corresponding statistical numbers in the official edition of the Brussels Nomenclature and, in an appendix to this issue, publish the approved SITC-BTN III.

7. The present paper, including the SITC-BTN III, is intended for submission to the eleventh session of the Statistical Commission. It is being circulated, in advance of submission, to Governments and interested international agencies; views which they send to the Statistical Office before 1 March 1960 will be taken into account by the Commission when it considers the SITC-BTN III. In presenting views it should be borne in mind that the Commission is not likely to wish, during its session, to consider detailed proposals for changes in items or groupings of the SITC-BTN III but would primarily wish to know whether Governments consider that the steps taken by the Expert Group should be approved and whether the resulting document constitutes an acceptable system for international use. The Expert Group^{5/} which drafted the SITC-BTN III recognized the necessity of:

(a) keeping to a minimum the number of BTN headings that the Customs Cooperation Council would be asked to subdivide in ways not already implicit in the Brussels Explanatory Notes,

(b) arranging that statistics according to the SITC-BTN III should, as far as possible, be readily comparable with those according to the original SITC.

In considering the second of these points, the Expert Group kept in mind that it is easy to obtain figures for a heading of the original SITC by adding two or more headings of the SITC-BTN III (or vice versa) only if data by countries of origin or destination are not required. Since data by origin and destination have been regularly published down to the SITC group (5-digit code) level, an effort was made to preserve all meaningful groups of the original SITC or, if a meaningful group was subdivided, to provide

that the old group could be reproduced, mechanographically, at the new division (2-digit code) level. Thus, for instance, the old groups 412 and 681 are the same as the new divisions 42 and 67 respectively. In addition, it was possible to preserve most of the important items (5-digit code) of the original SITC, they appear in the SITC-BTN III as 4-digit subgroups. Notes to the SITC-BTN III indicate minor adjustments made to simplify correspondence with the BTN and unlikely seriously to affect statistics, countries now using the SITC have already incorporated some of these minor adjustments in their data so that, in these cases, the SITC-BTN III will be nearer to actual practice than the original SITC. These examples indicate that differences between the SITC-BTN III and the original SITC are often more apparent than real.

8. In view of these arrangements, the Statistical Commission may feel that it is possible to envisage a smooth transition which will result in replacing the SITC by what is now called the SITC-BTN III, and may wish to ask the Statistical Office:

- (a) to arrange the transition;
- (b) to revise the preliminary issue (1953) of the "Commodity Indexes for the SITC" to take account of the SITC-BTN III,
- (c) to publish in the modified SITC both the correlation code to the subdivided BTN and the subdivided Brussels nomenclature itself.

Once the transition is accomplished:

- (a) countries already using the BTN and the SITC would benefit from the simplified relation between them and from the fact that the precision of definition available for the BTN applies automatically to the SITC-BTN III,
- (b) countries using the BTN could readily introduce the SITC-BTN III for statistical purposes and thus profit from international comparability of statistics,
- (c) countries using the SITC would find their data readily comparable with those of countries introducing the SITC-BTN III;
- (d) countries using neither the BTN for the presentation of their customs tariff, nor the SITC for the compilation of their trade statistics, will find in the SITC-BTN III an instrument which will help them to join the countries which already co-operate in these fields.

9. The SITC-BTN III consists of 10 sections, essentially the same as those of the original SITC, 56 divisions, mostly the same as those of the original SITC (except that, as noted above, certain new divisions correspond to old groups), 177 groups, 626 sub-groups and 1312 items. The items of the SITC-BTN III serve primarily to assure a reciprocal one-to-one correspondence with the (subdivided) BTN, but some of them also have statistical importance.

10. As in the case of the original SITC, it is intended that countries wishing to expand or contract the SITC-BTN III should be free to do so. Countries wishing to distinguish more detail in a given item than is provided in the SITC-BTN III may either use vacant digits or, preferably, a sixth digit. Certain expansions which may be useful to European countries are indicated in footnotes to the SITC-BTN III, they are not, however, part of the SITC-BTN III proper. Countries wishing to contract SITC-BTN III headings may do so by replacing digits, beginning at the right of the SITC-BTN III number, by zeros until the desired degree of detail is reached. A country which wishes not to sub-divide transport equipment would, for instance, classify all such equipment under the summary heading 730.0.

11. In the SITC-BTN III, BTN items are identified by their numbers and, where possible, by the title given them in the BTN. Where the BTN title was too long for reproduction in full, a shorter title was used. In these cases the difference in wording is not to be taken to imply a difference in content; the content is fully determined by the BTN number.
