SUMMARY

The present report contains information on the progress of the work of the Statistical Division of the United Nations Secretariat during the biennium January 1992-December 1993, including a summary of major accomplishments (paras. 4-5), a review of departures from originally programmed outputs/services (paras. 6-8) and a comprehensive report on the status of all outputs and services programmed for the biennium 1992-1993 (annex II). Points for discussion are given in paragraph 9.

## INTRODUCTION

1. The present report provides information on the status of outputs and services contained in the work programme of the Statistical Division of the United Nations Secretariat (UNSTAT) for the biennium 1992-1993. It is compiled from the material prepared in connection with the report of the Secretary-General on programme performance, to be submitted to the Committee for Programme and Coordination at its thirty-fourth session, scheduled for May 1994.

2. In response to the request of the Statistical Commission and its Working Group on International Statistical Programmes and Coordination, information on programme implementation is presented in terms of subject-matter areas. This practice was initiated in the reports submitted to the Commission at its twenty-seventh session (see E/CN.3/1993/22 and E/CN.3/1993/23). The classification used is derived from the Administrative Committee on Coordination (ACC) programme classification, which is broadly in use in the United Nations system for reporting on programmes on a system-wide basis. The classification is reproduced in annex I. Annex II contains comprehensive information on the status of each output or service in the Statistical Division's work programme for 1992-1993; within each subject-matter area, outputs and services are further classified in accordance with the United Nations subprogrammes in global statistics. 1/

3. Information on the work programme of UNSTAT for the biennium 1994-1995 was presented to the Commission at its twenty-seventh session, in 1993, in documents E/CN.3/1993/25 and E/CN.3/1993/CRP.1. The comments of the Commission on the statistics work programme were taken into account in developing the final proposed programme budget for the biennium 1994-1995. These were submitted by the Secretary-General to the General Assembly at its forty-eighth session for approval (see A/48/6 (Sect. 9)).

### I. MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF THE GLOBAL STATISTICAL PROGRAMME IN THE BIENNIUM 1992-1993

4. During the biennium 1992-1993, UNSTAT faced a number of special challenges. These included the impact of the continuing budget difficulties of the Organization, as well as a two-phased restructuring of the economic and social sectors of the Secretariat that had an unintended consequence of locating UNSTAT in three different departments in a two-year period. Despite these challenges, the biennium 1992-1993 was a period of particularly high productivity for UNSTAT, with a number of longer-term efforts and several new initiatives reaching a successful conclusion.

5. Some of the major accomplishments in statistics during the biennium included:

/...

(a) Demographic and social statistics:

(i) Population:

a. Publication of four volumes of the Handbook of Population and Housing Censuses, and a technical report on the Demographic Sample Survey;

b. Development of a census information database and inventory consisting of national census questionnaires, enumeration manuals and other reports relating to the 1990 round of population and housing censuses;

c. Workshops on civil registration and vital statistics were held at Damascus for countries in Western Asia and at Beijing for countries in South and East Asia as part of the International Programme for Accelerating the Improvement of Vital Statistics and Civil Registration Systems. In addition, with the assistance of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) and the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), feasibility studies were carried out in five countries to assess the current situation and identify measures to improve civil registration and vital statistics in those countries;

(ii) Women (gender statistics):

a. Planning work and fund raising was completed for preparation of the second issue of The World's Women, to be published as part of the documentation for the Fourth World Conference on Women: Action for Equality, Development and Peace, to be held at Beijing in September 1995;

b. The User's Guide and Reference Manual for the Women's Indicators and Statistics Database (Wistat) was published, with continuing UNFPA support. Work on the third issue of Wistat is well under way;

(iii) Special population groups:

a. A special issue of the Demographic Yearbook, devoted to the ageing population and the situation of the elderly, was completed and sent for publication;

b. The Statistical Chart on Families was prepared and published, in collaboration with the secretariat of the International Year of the Family. More than 15,000 copies were distributed around the world in observance of the International Year of the Family in 1994;

c. Work on the review of the International Classification of Impairments, Disabilities and Handicaps is well under way, in cooperation with the World Health Organization (WHO), the United

States National Centre for Health Statistics, the Central Bureau of Statistics of the Netherlands and Statistics Canada;

d. The International Workshop on the Development and Dissemination of Statistics on Persons with Disabilities was held at Ottawa in 1992, in cooperation with Statistics Canada and WHO;

(b) Economic statistics:

(i) National accounts:

a. The revised System of National Accounts (SNA) was adopted by the Statistical Commission at its twenty-seventh session and the English version was published in February 1994 as System of National Accounts, 1993 as a joint publication of the Statistical Office of the European Communities (EUROSTAT), the International Monetary Fund (IMF), the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), the United Nations and the World Bank;

b. The Interregional Seminar on the Revision of the SNA and the sixth and last Expert Group Meeting on SNA Coordination were held at Aguascalientes, Mexico, in October 1992;

c. Trends in International Distribution of Gross World Product was published as a special issue of the National Accounts Statistics yearbook;

(ii) Industry:

a. Coding links between major international classifications for industrial commodity production data were developed and published in volume II of the Industrial Statistics Yearbook;

b. A technical report, entitled "Strategies for measuring industrial structure and growth", was completed and submitted for publication;

(iii) International trade:

a. Coverage and timeliness of data in the COMTRADE database has been sharply increased;

b. Commodity Indexes for SITC, Revision 3, were incorporated into COMTRADE and a monthly report, "Comtrade Notes", was initiated to assist users;

c. There was a major reduction in the time needed to complete work on the most recent edition of the International Trade Statistics Yearbook (contains 1992 data);

d. Commodity Indexes to SITC, Rev.3 (vols. I and II) are ready for submission for publication;

(iv) Prices:

a. The Handbook of the International Comparison Programme (ICP) was published and technical documentation on the "Provisional list of core items with detailed specifications" was prepared and circulated;

b. An expert group meeting was held at Philadelphia in January 1993 to discuss the methodological and organizational issues for the implementation of the 1993 comparison of the ICP;

(v) General statistics:

a. An expert group meeting was held at United Nations Headquarters in February 1993 to review the Statistical Yearbook and the Monthly Bulletin of Statistics;

b. The Statistical Yearbook was redesigned and the thirty-eighth edition was published;

c. The Statistical Yearbook CD-ROM was developed and released as a United Nations sales publication;

(c) Other statistics:

(i) Environment statistics:

a. The Handbook on Integrated Environmental and Economic Accounting was published;

b. Pilot studies in integrated environmental and economic accounts were carried out in several developing countries;

(ii) Coordination:

a. UNSTAT promoted broad-based improvement in coordination across priority subject areas, largely through active participation in and support for the inter-agency task forces established by the Commission;

b. UNSTAT completed a significant review and initiated a realignment of compilation activities involving bilateral and multilateral agreements among agencies in trade and industrial statistics to improve the cost-effectiveness of the work and reduce the burden on countries;

c. UNSTAT successfully promoted and initiated actions in line with the 19 recommendations and decisions of the Statistical Commission (February 1993) on strengthening international statistical cooperation.

## II. DEPARTURES FROM PROGRAMMED OUTPUTS/SERVICES

6. Initially, 144 outputs 2/ were included in the UNSTAT work programme for the biennium 1992-1993. An additional 57 outputs were subsequently added. Most of these related to work mandated by the Statistical Commission and activities that arose in connection with the review of global statistical systems and its follow-up. Taking into account both the original and the added outputs, a total of 201 activities were considered as programmed of which 167, or 83 per cent, were implemented before the end of 1993. 3/ Among the 34 outputs not completed by the end of 1993, 5 were formally terminated.

7. The formally terminated outputs were: (a) National Accounts Statistics: Analysis of Main Aggregates (34th and subsequent editions); (b) Directory of Technical Cooperation in Statistics; (c) Methods of Collecting Statistics on Elderly Women; (d) a microcomputer template for industrial data reporting in connection with the World Programme of Industrial Statistics; and (e) summary compilation of available statistical indicators on the implementation of the Nairobi Forward-looking Strategies for the Advancement of Women.

8. The distribution of the remaining 29 unimplemented outputs by broad subject-matter is as follows: demographic and social statistics (11), economic statistics (11), general statistics (3), and other statistics, including environment statistics and classifications, (4). It may be noted that 3 of the 29 unimplemented outputs relate to manuscripts that have already been submitted for publication by UNSTAT and that work on an additional seven manuscripts is in the final stages of completion and review.

## III. POINTS FOR DISCUSSION

9. The Commission may wish to:

(a) Comment on the programme performance and implementation of UNSTAT during the biennium 1992-1993;

(b) Provide further guidance on priorities to be taken into account in implementing the work programme for 1994-1995;

(c) Comment on the format for presenting such information in the future.

### Notes

1/ The five subprogrammes of the Statistics programme are: 1. Developing statistical concepts and methods for use by Member States; 2. Applying advanced technology in collecting, processing and disseminating integrated statistics; 3. Collecting, compiling and disseminating international statistics; 4. Coordinating international statistical programmes; 5. Support for technical cooperation in statistics and statistical data processing.

2/ For simplicity, the term "output" is used here to cover both tangible outputs and specifically programmed services.

/...

3/ In the case of a publication or document, the term "implemented" means that it was actually printed and issued by the United Nations. It should be noted that the listing in annex II presents certain activities in somewhat greater detail than the information provided to the Committee for Programme and Coordination (CPC) so as to permit the presentation of work separately by subject-matter. Thus, annex II covers some 230 items, while only 201 items are officially identified in the report to CPC. All analysis in this section corresponds to the figures compiled for CPC.
