  - International economic and social classifications, including the *Revised List of Industrial Commodities*
  - Classifications (technical sub-group meetings)
  - Fourth revision of the Standard International Trade Classification
  - Manual of Environment Statistics
  - Millennium Development Goals indicators
  - Revision of the *Monthly Bulletin of Statistics*

3. Workshops will be held on the following themes:
- Collection and dissemination of disability statistics into the United Nations *Demographic Yearbook* system
  - *Demographic Yearbook*: improving fertility and mortality statistics in English-speaking Africa
  - Capacity-building in statistics for developing countries and countries with economies in transition in data collection, compilation and dissemination methods, with emphasis on censuses, inter-censal surveys and vital statistics from civil registries
  - Poverty (South Africa and Asia)
  - National accounts (Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) and Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia (ESCWA))
  - Energy statistics
  - Compilation of international merchandise trade statistics by partner/commodity
