Division for the biennium 2008-2009****Note by the Secretariat**

1. The draft programme of work in the field of statistics for the biennium 2008-2009, which is contained in the annex to the present note, is submitted for the consideration of the Statistical Commission in compliance with the Regulations and Rules Governing Programme Planning, the Programme Aspects of the Budget, the Monitoring of Implementation and the Methods of Evaluation.¹ The General Assembly, in its resolution 58/269, decided that the programme narratives of the programme budget fascicles would be identical to the biennial programme plan. In this connection, the General Assembly, in its resolution 61/235 has approved the biennial programme plan for the period 2008-2009, which has incorporated the programme narrative, namely the objectives, expected accomplishments of the Secretariat and indicators of achievement, of the statistics subprogramme.

2. The draft programme of work, which includes information on outputs, has been formulated within the framework of subprogramme 5 (Statistics) of programme 9 (Economic and social affairs) of the biennial programme plan for the period 2008-2009.

3. The Commission is invited to take note of the programme narrative and review the proposed outputs to be included in the Secretary-General's proposed programme budget for the biennium 2008-2009, which will be submitted to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions and to the General Assembly at its sixty-second session.

Draft programme of work for the biennium 2008-2009 for the Statistics Division, Department of Economic and Social Affairs

Objectives

To advance the global statistical system in order to produce high quality, easily accessible comparable national statistics for policymakers and other users at the national and international levels.

^a Outputs (i) to (iv) are required to support specific programmes and priorities for developing statistical capacity-building, such as censuses, surveys of various kinds, environment statistics, analytical reporting, as is done with MDG indicators of various kinds, and collaboration with international funds, agencies and programmes in achieving coordinated national statistical programmes.
