1992/230. Right to a fair trial

At its 32nd plenary meeting, on 20 July 1992, the Economic and Social Council, recalling its resolution 1991/28 of 3 l May 1991 and Commission on Human Rights resolution 1991/43 of 5 March 1991²² and taking note of Commission resolution 1992/34 of 28 February 1992, ¹⁹ ap-proved the endorsement by the Commission of the request of the Subcommission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities, in its resolution 1991/14 of 28 August 1991,²¹ to Mr Stanislav Chernichenko and Mr. William Treat to continue the preparation of their study on the right to a fair trial: current recognition and measures necessary for its strengthening, and also approved the Commission's request to the Secretary-General to provide

the Special Rapporteurs with all the assistance they might require in this task.
