

1992/234. Discrimination against people infected with the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) or with acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS)

At its 32nd plenary meeting, on 20 July 1992, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1992/56 of 3 March 1992,¹⁹ approved the endorsement by the Commission of the requests of the Subcommission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities, in its decision 1991/109 of 29 August 1991,²⁴ to its Special Rapporteur, Mr. Luis Varela Quirós, to submit his final report to the Subcommission at its forty-fourth session, and to the Secretary-General to give the Special Rapporteur such assistance as he might require to accomplish his work.
