1992/253. Study on treaties, agreements and other constructive arrangements between States and indigenous populations

At its 32nd plenary meeting, on 20 July 1992, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights decision 1992/111 of 28 February 1992¹² and decision 1991/111 of 29 August 1991 of the Subcommission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities,²⁴ approved the endorsement by the Commission of the requests of the Subcommission: (a) to Mr. Miguel Alfonso Martínez to prepare a progress report on treaties, agreements and other constructive arrangements between States and indigenous populations for submission to the Working Group on Indigenous Populations at its tenth session and the Subcommission at its forty-fourth session, and (b) to the Secretary-General to give the Special Rapporteur all the assistance necessary to allow him to continue his work, in particular to provide for a second study trip to the Archivo de Indias at Seville, Spain, the specialized research assistance required, as provided for in previous resolutions adopted on this matter, and the necessary trips to Geneva for consultations at the Centre for Human Rights of the Secretariat.
