

1992/258. Organization of the work of the forty-ninth session of the Commission on Human Rights

At its 32nd plenary meeting, on 20 July 1992, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights decision 1992/119 of 6 March 1992,¹² decided to authorize, if possible within existing financial resources, forty fully serviced additional meetings, including the provision of summary records, for the Commission's forty-ninth session, and took note of the Commission's decision to request the Chairman of the Commission at its forty-ninth session to make every effort to organize the work of the session within the time normally allotted, the additional meetings to be utilized only if they proved to be absolutely necessary.
