

**1992/263. Documents considered by the Economic and Social Council in connection with the question of human rights**

At its 32nd plenary meeting, on 20 July 1992, the Economic and Social Council took note of the following documents:

(a) Report of the Secretary-General on regional arrangements for the promotion and protection of human rights in the Asian and Pacific region;<sup>30</sup>

(b) Note by the Secretariat transmitting the section of the report of the Ad Hoc Working Group of Experts on southern Africa of the Commission on Human Rights relevant to the situation regarding allegations of infringements of trade union rights in South Africa;<sup>31</sup>

(c) Report of the Secretary-General on the suppression of the traffic in persons and of the exploitation of the prostitution of others;<sup>32</sup>
