1995/268. Assistance to Guatemala in the field of human rights

At its 52nd plenary meeting, on 25 July 1995, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1995/51 of 3 March 1995, ⁶¹ approved the Commission's request to the Secretary-General to extend the mandate of the independent expert so that, taking into account the work of the United Nations Mission for the Verification of Human Rights and of Compliance with the Commitments of the Comprehensive Agreement on Human Rights in Guatemala, she might continue to examine the situation of human rights in Guatemala, provide assistance to the Government in the field of human rights, and submit to the Commission, at its fifty-second session, a report evaluating the measures taken by the Government in accordance with the recommendations made to it.
