

1995/298. Study on treaties, agreements and other constructive arrangements between States and indigenous populations

At its 52nd plenary meeting, on 25 July 1995, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on

Human Rights decision 1995/109 of 3 March 1995,⁶¹ and decision 1994/116 of 26 August 1994 of the Subcommission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities,⁶² endorsed the recommendation that the Special Rapporteur, Mr. Miguel Alfonso Martínez, make all possible efforts to submit his second progress report in 1995 to the Working Group on Indigenous Populations of the Subcommission at its thirteenth session and to the Subcommission at its forty-seventh session, as well as his final report to both bodies in 1996. The Council also endorsed the recommendation to request the Secretary-General to give the Special Rapporteur all the necessary assistance to allow him to continue his work, in particular by providing for the specialized research assistance required and for the necessary trips to Geneva for consultation with the Centre for Human Rights of the Secretariat, and the resources needed for a research mission to the Vatican archives in Rome.
