

1995/301. Organization of the work of the fifty-second session of the Commission on Human Rights

At its 52nd plenary meeting, on 25 July 1995, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights decision 1995/115 of 10 March 1995,⁶¹ approved:

(a) The Commission's recommendation to authorize, if possible within existing financial resources, forty fully-serviced additional meetings, including summary records, in accordance with rules 29 and 31 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Council, for the Commission's fifty-second session;

(b) The Commission's request to the Chairperson of the Commission at its fifty-second session to make every effort to organize the work of the session within the time normally allotted, the additional meetings that the Council might authorize to be utilized only if such meetings proved to be absolutely necessary.
