## 1995/320. Membership of the Commission on Population and Development

At its 60th plenary meeting, on 12 December 1995, the Economic and Social Council decided:
(a) That the membership of the Commission on Population and Development should be increased from twentyseven to forty-seven, according to the following pattern:

Twelve members from African States;
Eleven members from Asian States;
Five members from Eastern European States;
Nine members from Latin American and Caribbean States;

Ten members from Western European and other States;
(b) That the members of the Commission should be elected by the Council from among the States Members of the United Nations and members of the specialized agen-cies before the opening of the twenty-ninth session of the Commission.
