Question of the realization in all countries of the economic, social and cultural rights contained in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and in the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and study of special problems which the developing countries face in their efforts to achieve these human rights

At its 46th plenary meeting, on 23 July 1996, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1996/11 of 11 April 1996,61 approved the Commission's recommendation to the Centre for Human Rights of the Secretariat to convene, as a follow-up to the seminar on appropriate indicators to measure achievements in the progressive realization of economic, social and cultural rights, held in 1993, expert seminars focused on specific economic, social and cultural rights with a view to clarifying the particular content of those rights.
