

**1996/305. Follow-up to General Assembly resolution
50/106: business and development**

At its 52nd plenary meeting, on 26 July 1996, the Economic and Social Council, having taken note of General Assembly resolution 50/106 of 20 December 1995 and having considered at its substantive session of 1996, under agenda item 6 (i), the issue of illicit payments, to which that resolution related, and having also taken note of the draft resolution²¹⁵ containing a United Nations declaration on corruption and bribery in transnational commercial activities submitted under that item:

(a) Decided to continue consideration of agenda item 6 (i), including the above-mentioned draft resolution, at its resumed substantive session of 1996;

(b) Requested the President of the Economic and Social Council to continue to facilitate open-ended consultations prior to its resumed substantive session, with a view to enhancing the prospects for achieving consensus.
