

1997/262. Situation of human rights in Haiti

At its 38th plenary meeting, on 22 July 1997, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1997/52 of 15 April 1997,³⁹ approved the Commission's request to the General Assembly to study the possibility of extending the mandate of the International Civilian Mission to Haiti, which expires in July 1997, and its invitation to the independent expert to inform the General Assembly at its fifty-second session and the Commission on Human Rights at its fifty-fourth session on the development of the human rights situation in Haiti.
