## 1997/264. Situation of human rights in the Islamic Republic of Iran

At its 38th plenary meeting, on 22 July 1997, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1997/54 of 15 April 1997, <sup>39</sup> endorsed the Commission's decision to extend for a further year the mandate of the Special Representative on the situation of human rights in the Islamic Republic of Iran, as contained in Commission resolution 1984/54 of 14 March 1984, <sup>47</sup> approved the Commission's request to the Special Representative to submit an interim report to the General Assembly at its fifty-second session on the situation of human rights in the Islamic Republic of Iran, to report to the Commission at its fifty-fourth session, and to keep a gender perspective in mind when seeking and analysing information, and approved the Commission's decision to request the Secretary-General to continue to give all necessary assistance to the Special Representative to enable him to discharge his mandate fully.
