1997/271. Situation of human rights in Cuba

At its 38th plenary meeting, on 22 July 1997, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1997/62 of 16 April 1997,³⁹ endorsed the Commission's decision to extend for one year the mandate of the Special Rapporteur of the Commission on Human Rights on the situation of human rights in Cuba, approved its request to the Secretary-General to provide all necessary assistance to the Special Rapporteur, and also approved the Commission's request to the Special Rapporteur to submit an interim report to the General Assembly at its fifty-second session and a report to the Commission at its fifty-fourth session on the results of his endeavours pursuant to Commission resolution 1997/62.
