## 1997/272. Situation of human rights in Myanmar

At its 38th plenary meeting, on 22 July 1997, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights resolution 1997/64 of 16 April 1997, <sup>39</sup> endorsed the Commission's decision to extend for a further year the mandate of the Special Rapporteur of the Commission on Human Rights on the situation of human rights in Myanmar, as contained in Commission resolution 1992/58 of 3 March 1992, <sup>52</sup> and to request the Special Rapporteur to submit an interim report to the General Assembly at its fifty-second session and a report to the Commission at its fifty-fourth session, keeping a gender perspective in mind when seeking and analysing information, and also approved the Commission's request to the Secretary-General to continue to give all necessary assistance to the Special Rapporteur to enable him to discharge his mandate fully.
