1997/287. Protection of the heritage of indigenous people

At its 38th plenary meeting, on 22 July 1997, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights decision 1997/112 of 11 April 1997⁵³ and resolution 1996/37 of 29 August 1996 of the Subcommission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities, of endorsed the Commission's decision to recommend that the Special Rapporteur on the protection of the heritage of indigenous people, Ms. Erica-Irene A. Daes, be entrusted with a continuing mandate to exchange information with all parts of the United Nations system involved in activities concerned with the heritage of indigenous people, with a view to facilitating cooperation and coordination and to promoting the full participation of indigenous people in those efforts, and approved the Commission's request to the Secretary-General to provide the Special Rapporteur with all the assistance necessary to accomplish her work.
