

**1998/281. Organization of the work of the fifty-fifth session of the Commission on Human Rights**

At its 46th plenary meeting, on 30 July 1998, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights decision 1998/111 of 22 April 1998,<sup>56</sup> authorized, if possible within existing financial resources, thirty fully serviced additional meetings, including summary records, in accordance with rules 29 and 31 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council, for the fifty-fifth session of the Commission, and approved the request of the Commission to the Chairman of the Commission at its fifty-fifth session to make every effort to organize the work of the session within the times normally allotted so that the additional meetings authorized by the Council would be utilized only if they proved to be absolutely necessary.
