Organization of the work of the fifty-eighth session of the Commission on Human Rights

At its 40th plenary meeting, on 24 July 2001, the Economic and Social Council, taking note of Commission on Human Rights decision 2001/118 of 27 April 2001,¹ authorized, for the Commission's fifty-eighth session, if possible from within existing financial resources, 35 fully serviced additional meetings, including summary records, in accordance with rules 29 and 31 of the rules of procedure of the functional commissions of the Economic and Social Council.

The Council approved the Commission's request to the Chairperson of the fifty-eighth session of the Commission to make every effort to organize the work of the session within the times normally allotted, so that the additional meetings that the Council might authorize would be utilized only if they proved to be absolutely necessary.
