

## **ECOSOC Decision 2004/276**

### **Traditional practices affecting the health of women and the girl child**

At its 49th plenary meeting, on 22 July 2004, the Economic and Social Council took note of Commission on Human Rights decision 2004/111 of 20 April 2004<sup>1</sup> and endorsed the Commission's decision to renew the mandate of the Special Rapporteur on traditional practices affecting the health of women and the girl child for a further three years and its request to the Special Rapporteur to submit an updated report to the Subcommission on the Promotion and Protection of Human Rights at its fifty-sixth session.
