The universal implementation of international human rights treaties

At its 49th plenary meeting, on 22 July 2004, the Economic and Social Council took note of Commission on Human Rights decision 2004/123 of 21 April 2004¹ and approved the Commission's decision to appoint Mr. Emmanuel Decaux special rapporteur to conduct a detailed study of the universal implementation of international human rights treaties based on his working paper,² the comments made and the discussions that took place at the fifty-fifth session of the Subcommission on the Promotion and Protection of Human Rights, and its decision to request the Special Rapporteur to submit a preliminary report to the Subcommission at its fifty-sixth session, an interim report at its fifty-seventh session and a final report at its fifty-eighth session.

The Council also endorsed the Commission's request to the Secretary-General to provide the Special Rapporteur with all the necessary assistance to enable him to carry out his mandate, inter alia in his contacts with States.
