International expert group meeting on the Convention on Biological Diversity international regime on access and benefit-sharing and indigenous people's human rights

At its 48th meeting, on 15 December 2006, the Economic and Social Council decided to authorize a three-day international expert group meeting on the Convention on Biological Diversity international regime on access and benefit-sharing and indigenous people's human rights with the participation of representatives from the United Nations system, and five members of the Permanent Forum on Indigenous Issues, and invited other interested intergovernmental organizations, experts from indigenous organizations, and interested Member States to participate as well, and requested that the results of the meeting be reported to the Permanent Forum at its sixth session in May 2007.
