At its 10th meeting, on 13 April 2022, in accordance with ECOSOC resolution 1981/50, the Council elected, by acclamation, ALGERIA, BAHRAIN, CAMEROON, CHILE, CHINA, COSTA RICA, CUBA, ERITREA, INDIA, ISRAEL, LIBERIA, NICARAGUA, PAKISTAN, TURKEY, UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHER IRELAND, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and ZIMBABWE, as members of the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations for a four year term of office beginning on 1 January 2023, to fill vacancies occurring on the expiration of the terms of office of BAHRAIN, BRAZIL, BURUNDI, CHINA, CUBA, ESTONIA, ESWATINI, GREECE, INDIA, ISRAEL, LIBYA, MEXICO, NICARAGUA, NIGERIA, PAKISTAN, RUSSIAN FEDERATION, SUDAN, TURKEY and UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

The Council also elected, by secret ballot, ARMENIA and GEORGIA as members of the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2023.

As a result, as of 1 January 2023, the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations is composed of the following 19 Member States whose terms of office expire on 31 December 2026:

ALGERIA, ARMENIA, BAHRAIN, CAMEROON, CHILE, CHINA, COSTA RICA, CUBA, ERITREA, GEORGIA, INDIA, ISRAEL, LIBERIA, NICARAGUA, PAKISTAN, TURKEY, UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and ZIMBABWE.
