Decision text A

At its 17th plenary meeting, held on 5 April 2023, the Economic and Social Council, in accordance with the annex to its resolution 2008 (LX) and General Assembly decision 42/450, nominated, by acclamation, for election by the General Assembly as members of the Committee for Programme and Coordination, ARMENIA, BRAZIL, CAMEROON, CÔTE D'IVOIRE, GERMANY, INDIA, IRAN (ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF), ISRAEL, ITALY, JAPAN, MEXICO, PAKISTAN, RWANDA, SOUTH AFRICA, the UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and URUGUAY for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2024, to fill vacancies occurring on the expiration of the terms of office of ARMENIA, BELARUS, BRAZIL, CAMEROON, COSTA RICA, CUBA, the DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, ERITREA, ESWATINI, GERMANY, INDIA, IRAN (ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF), ITALY, JAPAN, MALI, MALTA, PAKISTAN, POLAND, the UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

As of 5 April 2023, three vacancies for election by the General Assembly remain to be filled on the Committee as follows: two for members from Eastern European States and one for a member from the Latin American and Caribbean States for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2024.

B

At its 26th plenary meeting, held on 7 June 2023, the Economic and Social Council, in accordance with the annex to its resolution 2008 (LX) and General Assembly decision 42/450, nominated, by acclamation, for election by the General Assembly as members of the Committee for Programme and Coordination, POLAND for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2024.

As of 7 June 2023, two vacancies for election by the General Assembly remain to be filled on the Committee for Programme and Coordination as follows: one from the Eastern European States and one from the Latin American and Caribbean States for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2024.
