Decision text

At its 17th plenary meeting, on 5 April 2023, the Economic and Social Council, in accordance with its resolutions 1982/67 and 1985/71, elected, by acclamation, ALGERIA, CAMBODIA, CHINA, ECUADOR, THE GAMBIA, GERMANY, GUATEMALA, the KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS, NIGERIA, PERU, the RUSSIAN FEDERATION, SAUDI ARABIA, TOGO, TÜRKIYE, the UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and ZIMBABWE as members of the Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2024 to fill vacancies occurring on the expiration of the terms of office of: CAMEROON, CHINA, CÔTE D'IVOIRE, ECUADOR, EGYPT, THE GAMBIA, GERMANY, GUATEMALA, ITALY, NETHERLANDS (KINGDOM OF THE), NIGERIA, the RUSSIAN FEDERATION, SAUDI ARABIA, TÜRKIYE, the UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

As a result, as of 1 January 2024, the Intergovernmental Working Group of Expert on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting is composed of the following 29 Member States:

ALGERIA**, BRAZIL*, CAMBODIA**, CHAD*, CHINA**, COLOMBIA*, ECUADOR**, THE GAMBIA**, GERMANY**, GUATEMALA**, KAZAKHSTAN*, KENYA*, KYRGYZSTAN*, MAURITANIA*, MEXICO*, MOROCCO*, NETHERLANDS (KINGDOM OF THE)**, NIGERIA**, NORTH MACEDONIA*, PERU**, the PHILIPPINES*, RUSSIAN FEDERATION**, SAUDI ARABIA**, TOGO**, TÜRKIYE**, UKRAINE*, the UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND**, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA** and ZIMBABWE**.

As of 5 April 2023, the following ten vacancies remain to be filled on the Intergovernmental Working Group: one vacancy each from Asia-Pacific States and Latin American and Caribbean States, and three vacancies from Western European and other States, all for a term of office beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2023; one vacancy from Asia-Pacific States for a term of office beginning on the date of election and expiring on 31 December 2024; and four vacancies from Western European and other States for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2024.
