

Decision 2017/208

Themes for the 2017, 2018 and 2019 sessions of the Economic and Social Council

At its 5th plenary meeting, on 23 November 2016, the Economic and Social Council, recalling General Assembly resolution 70/299 of 29 July 2016, entitled “Follow-up and review of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development at the global level”, and without prejudice to the review by the Assembly of its resolution 68/1 of 20 September 2013, entitled “Review of the implementation of General Assembly resolution 61/16 on the strengthening of the Economic and Social Council”, to be conducted by the Assembly at its seventy-second session, decided that the main themes for the 2017, 2018 and 2019 sessions of the Council would be:

- (a) 2017 session (July 2016 to July 2017): “Eradicating poverty in all its forms and dimensions through promoting sustainable development, expanding opportunities and addressing related challenges”;
- (b) 2018 session (July 2017 to July 2018): “From global to local: supporting sustainable and resilient societies in urban and rural communities”;
- (c) 2019 session (July 2018 to July 2019): “One world for all: empowering people to build equal and inclusive societies”.
