

Decision 2019/203

Division of responsibilities of the Bureau of the Economic and Social Council for the 2019 session

At its 4th plenary meeting, on 19 October 2018, the Economic and Social Council decided that the division of responsibilities in the Bureau for the 2019 session would be as follows: the President, Inga Rhonda King (Saint Vincent and the Grenadines), would be responsible for the high-level segment, the high-level political forum on sustainable development convened under the auspices of the Council, the forum on financing for development follow-up, the multi-stakeholder forum on science, technology and innovation for the Sustainable Development Goals, the special meeting on international cooperation in tax matters, as well as any joint meetings and other special meetings that may be convened should the need arise; the Vice-President, Teodoro Lopez Locsin, Jr. (Philippines), would be responsible for the operational activities for the development segment; the Vice-President, Omar Hilale (Morocco), would be responsible for the humanitarian affairs segment; the Vice-President, Valentin Rybakov (Belarus), would be responsible for the integration segment; and the Vice-President, Tore Hattrem (Norway), would be responsible for the management meetings, including the elections to fill the vacancies in the subsidiary and related bodies of the Council.
