Decision 2019/233

Report of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names on its 2019 session – recommendation 4

At its 36th plenary meeting, on 23 July 2019, the Economic and Social Council decided that the Bureau of the United Nations Group of Experts on Geographical Names, through the Task Team for Africa, shall continue to urge the Economic Commission for Africa to collaborate with the Group of Experts, for example on the development of the GeoNyms application and implementation of the Gaborone Action Plan on Geographical Names Activities in Africa, as steps to achieve geographical names standardization in the countries of Africa.
