

**1998/6. Revision of the medium-term plan, 1998–2001, of the Economic Commission for Africa**

*The Economic and Social Council,*

*Having considered* the note by the secretariat of the Economic Commission for Africa on the first revision to the medium-term plan, 1998–2001,<sup>19</sup>

*Recalling* Commission resolution 809 (XXXI) of 8 May 1996, in which the Commission endorsed the medium-term plan for the period 1998–2001, in the context of the new directions for the Commission,<sup>17</sup>

*Recalling also* Commission resolutions 810 (XXXI) of 8 May 1996<sup>17</sup> and 828 (XXXII) of 8 May 1997,<sup>20</sup> in which the Commission called, respectively, for the strengthening of the multinational programming and operational centres and for their transformation into subregional development centres with an extended programme and policy orientation, as well as resolution 824 (XXXI) of 8 May 1996 entitled “Follow-up to the Dakar and Beijing conferences: implementation of the global and regional platforms for action for the advancement of women”,<sup>17</sup>

*Endorses* the revision to the medium-term plan, 1998–2001, involving the establishment of two new subprogrammes: “Promoting the advancement of women” and “Supporting subregional activities for development”.
