At its 12th plenary meeting, on 9 April 2024, the Economic and Social Council, in accordance with its resolution 1147 (XLI) of 4 August 1966, elected, by acclamation, the DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, ITALY, MEXICO, POLAND, SWITZERLAND and the UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND as members of the Statistical Commission for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2025.

The Council also elected, by secret ballot, JAPAN and the UNITED ARAB EMIRATES as members of the Statistical Commission for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2025.

The newly elected members will fill vacancies occurring on the expiration of the terms of office of COLOMBIA, GERMANY, HUNGARY, JAPAN, MEXICO, SAMOA, SWITZERLAND and UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND. As a result, as of 1 January 2025, the Statistical Commission is composed of the following 24 Member States: ARGENTINA **, AUSTRALIA*, BURUNDI *, CUBA *, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC***, FINLAND *, INDIA**, ITALY***, JAPAN***, MEXICO***, NETHERLANDS (KINGDOM OF THE)*, POLAND***, REPUBLIC OF KOREA**, RUSSIAN FEDERATION*, SIERRA LEONE**, SLOVENIA**, SWITZERLAND***, TUNISIA *, UKRAINE**, UNITED ARAB EMIRATES***, UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND***, UNITED REPUBLIC OF TANZANIA**, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA** and ZAMBIA *.
