At its 14th plenary meeting, on 4 April 2025, the Economic and Social Council in accordance with its resolution 1991/49, elected, by acclamation BOLIVIA (PLURINATIONAL STATE OF), BURKINA FASO, COLOMBIA, CÔTE D'IVOIRE, GHANA, HONDURAS, MAURITANIA AND TRINIDAD and TOBAGO as members of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2026.

The Council also elected, by secret ballot, AUSTRALIA, BELGIUM, FRANCE, GERMANY, KAZAKHSTAN, KYRGYZSTAN, LITHUANIA, PAKISTAN, SLOVENIA, SWITZERLAND, UKRAINE and UNITED ARAB EMIRATES as members of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs for a four-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2026.

The newly elected members will fill vacancies occurring on the expiration of the terms of office of ALGERIA, AUSTRALIA, BANGLADESH, BELGIUM, BOLIVIA (PLURINATIONAL STATES OF), BRAZIL, CANADA, COLOMBIA, CÔTE D'IVOIRE, FRANCE, GHANA, IRAN (ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF), LITHUANIA, REPUBLIC OF KOREA, RUSSIAN FEDERATION, SAUDI ARABIA, SLOVENIA, SWITZERLAND, TRINIDAD and TOBABGO and TUNISIA.
