**Non-governmental organizations****Report of the Committee on Non-Governmental  
Organizations on its 2025 resumed session *AS ADOPTED*****(New York, 19-23 & 28-29 May & 5 June 2025)***Summary*

At its 2025 resumed session, held from 19 to 23 and 28 to 29 May, and 5 June 2025, the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations had before it 614 applications for consultative status, including 356 applications deferred from earlier sessions. Of the non-governmental organizations submitting those applications, the Committee recommended 170 for consultative status, deferred 381 for further consideration at its regular session in 2026 and closed without prejudice consideration of 63 applications of non-governmental organizations that had failed to respond to queries by the deadline of two business days (48 hours) before the beginning of each Committee session. The Committee took note of eight requests for a change of name. It also had before it 555 quadrennial reports, of which it took note of 401. The Committee heard eight representatives of non-governmental organizations.

The present report contains seven draft decisions on matters calling for action by the Economic and Social Council.

By draft decision I, the Council would:

- (a) Grant consultative status to 170 non-governmental organizations;
- (b) Note that the Committee decided to take note of the change of name of eight non-governmental organizations;
- (c) Note that the Committee took note of the quadrennial reports of 401 non-governmental organizations, including new and deferred reports;
- (d) Close without prejudice consideration of the requests for consultative status made by 63 non-governmental organizations after the organizations had failed to respond to queries by the deadline of two business days (48 hours) before the beginning of each Committee session;



By draft decision II, the Council would suspend, for a period of one year, the consultative status of 204 organizations with outstanding quadrennial reports.

By draft decision III, the Council would decide to reinstate the consultative status of 76 organizations that had submitted their outstanding quadrennial reports.

By draft decision IV, the Council would decide to withdraw the consultative status of 239 organizations with continued outstanding quadrennial reports.

Draft decision V, the Council would decide to withdraw the consultative status of one non-governmental organization, at the organizations' request

By draft decision VI, the Council would approve the dates and provisional agenda of the 2026 session of the Committee.

By draft decision VII, the Council would take note of the present report.

## **Draft decision II**

## **B. New quadrennial reports submitted by non-governmental organizations in consultative status with the Council**

14. At its 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting, on 23 May, the Committee considered agenda item 4 (b), New quadrennial reports submitted by non-governmental organizations in consultative status. It had before it notes by the Secretary-General containing 407 new quadrennial reports (E/C.2/2025/2/Add.5-10 and E/C.2/2025/CRP.49-74). The Committee took note of the quadrennial reports of 394 of the organizations (see chap. I, draft decision I, subpara. (c)). The Committee decided to defer consideration of the reports of the following 13 organizations<sup>2</sup>:

## **C. Other related matters**

### **Requests for a change of name**

15. At its 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting on 23 May, the Committee took note of the change of name of eight non-governmental organizations. It had before it a memorandum by the Secretary-General containing new requests from NGOs concerning a change of name (E/C.2/2025/CRP.45). The Committee took note of the change of name of eight nongovernmental organizations (see chap. I, draft decision I, subpara. (b)).

### **Request for withdrawal of consultative status**

16. At the same meeting, the Committee took note of the request for withdrawal of consultative status of one organization, due to changes in its status, as set out in document E/C.2/2025/CRP.46 (see chap. I, draft decision V).

## **IV. Strengthening of the Non-Governmental Organizations Branch of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs of the Secretariat**

17. At its 14<sup>th</sup> meeting, on 19 May, the Committee jointly considered the following agenda items and heard an oral report by the Secretariat: agenda item 5, Strengthening of the Non-Governmental Organizations Branch; agenda item 6, Review of the methods of work of the Committee: implementation of Council resolution 1996/31, including the process of accreditation of representatives of nongovernmental organizations, and Council decision 1995/304; and agenda item 8, General voluntary trust fund in support of the United Nations Non-Governmental Organizations Informal Regional Network.

18. The Chief of the Non-Governmental Organizations Branch noted that over the past several years, applications for consultative status had remained consistently near 1,000 annually, which was five times the volume received a decade ago. He stressed that this remarkable growth had significantly expanded the operational demands on the NGO Branch. However, the staffing and resources of the Branch had remained unchanged for more than a decade. The liquidity constraints had impacted the Branch's ability to process and present applications for consultative status in a timely manner, resulting in a significant backlog. He conveyed his deep concern over continued delays in efficient support for the Committee as well as NGOs, such as the review of quadrennial reports, catching up with increased numbers of deferred applications, designation procedures for accredited NGOs, and the development of a new ICT platform. He reiterated his appeal for continued support in securing the necessary resources that will enable the Branch to fully meet its responsibilities under ECOSOC Resolution 1996/31.

## **V. Review of the methods of work of the Committee: implementation of Council resolution 1996/31, including the process of accreditation of representatives of non-governmental organizations, and Council decision 1995/304**

19. At its 14<sup>th</sup> meeting, on 19 May, the Committee reviewed its methods of work.

20. The Department of Global Communications (DGC) informed the Secretary of the Committee on 20 May, that starting from the 18<sup>th</sup> meeting on 21 May the DGC the webcast services to the Committee would be discontinued unless a cost-recovery fee would be paid for the remaining 12 meetings of the Committee. Upon engagement with the DGC by the technical and substantive offices, the DGC agreed to “absorb the cost” and provide the webcasting for the remaining meetings on an “exceptional basis”.

21. At its 17<sup>th</sup> meeting on 20 May the Committee authorized the Vice-chair to reach out to the Under-Secretary-General for Global Communications requesting that the webcasting should be provided to all future sessions of the Committee as mandated by ECOSOC. The Vice-Chair's letter was transmitted to the office of the USG GDC on 28 May.

22. The representative of Algeria, with reference to agenda item 6 (a) *Working methods: Process of accreditation of representatives of non-governmental organizations* noted that sometimes NGO applications were submitted for review by the Committee that were clearly not eligible for ECOSOC consultative status. He proposed that the secretariat should not include these applications in the list for the Committee's consideration. For instance, one of the eligibility criteria was the resources of NGO. According to paragraph 13 of ECOSOC resolution 1996/31, the basic resources of the organization should be mainly derived from the organization members.

23. Regarding agenda item 6 (c) *Working methods: Other related matters*, the representative of Algeria stated that sometimes there were duplicate responses in the paperless system. He asked the secretariat to avoid such duplications because they artificially ballooned the number of answers and required additional time for review. He also asked for the rationale regarding the presentation of change of name requests and requested information on what such change would entail in terms of activities of the concerned NGOs as notification of change of name alone was not sufficient.

24. The Chief of the NGO Branch stated that there had been a delay in making the documentation on requests for name change available in the paperless system, but all related documents had been uploaded prior to the start of the session. With regard to the other proposals, he indicated that these may be taken up at the discussions of the informal working group.

25. At the 25<sup>th</sup> meeting on 29 May, the representative of India asked that the following suggestions be considered by the informal working group in order to organize the Q&A sessions with NGOs in a more efficient manner: (i) In view of the liquidity crisis and better time management, can the number of Q&A sessions be reduced to 3 from the present 5 sessions; (ii) Can only those NGOs that submitted their responses in writing be encouraged to participate in the Q&A session for a second time. He also asked if the secretariat could present in alphabetical order the compilation of applications for consultative status deferred from previous sessions of the Committee that have not responded to the last 3 reminders 2 business days (48 hours) before the beginning of the session. The Vice-Chair noted that he hoped to convene the informal working group shortly to take up these issues as well as the issues related to working methods that had been raised by other Committee members.

## **VI. Consideration of special reports and complaints by Member States**

26. At its 14<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> meetings, on 19 and 23 May, the Committee took up agenda item 7, Special reports. The representative of Azerbaijan briefed the Committee on the activities of the Non-Governmental Organization Christian Solidarity International. At the same meeting the Committee decided to transmit the statement by Azerbaijan to the NGO.

---

27. At its 22nd and 24th meetings on 23 and 28 May the representative of Egypt briefed the Committee on the legal status of the Non-Governmental Organization International Organization for Development and Environment which was recommended for consultative status at the 14th meeting on 19 May. The Committee decided to seek clarification from the NGO.

28. At its 24th meeting on 28 May the Committee decided to reconsider the application by the NGO, on an exceptional basis, under rule 57 of the rules of procedure of the Council. The NGO was requested to finalize its re-registration process with the Egyptian authorities.

## **VII. Provisional agenda and documentation of the 2026 session of the Committee**

29. At its 26th meeting, on 5 June, the Committee considered agenda item 9, Provisional agenda and documentation of the 2026 session of the Committee, and had before it the draft provisional agenda of its 2026 session (E/C.2/2025/L.1).

30. At the same meeting, the Committee decided to recommend to the Council the following dates for the sessions in 2026: a regular session, from 26 to 30 January and on 4 to 6 and 20 February, and a resumed session, from 18 to 22, 28-29 May and on 5 June.

## **VIII. Organization of the session**

### **A. Opening and duration of the session**

31. The Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations held its 2025 resumed session from 19-23, 28 - 29 May and 5 June. The Committee held 13 meetings.

32. The session was opened by the Vice-Chair.

33. In his opening remarks, the Vice-Chair of the 2025 session stated that the Committee served as an important gateway for NGOs to engage with and contribute to the work of the United Nations. By recommending the granting of consultative status to NGOs, the Committee facilitated their access and participation to the Council and its subsidiary bodies, as well as many United Nations meetings. He referred to the decision adopted by ECOSOC on 23 July 2024 entitled “Improving the work of the Committee on Non-Governmental Organizations”. He explained that in accordance with this decision the Secretariat would no longer compile lists that indicated the division of applicants into “list 1” or “list 2” in advance of the sessions of the Committee and the Committee would only review the lists South and North. He added that it had been decided to suspend the sessions for two working days between the fifth and sixth working days, and to establish a deadline for applicant responses to be received by the Secretariat and made available to the Committee by 5 p.m. on the day before the sixth working day. Finally, he reminded delegations of his communication dated 10 April 2025 where he relayed to the Committee that due to the Liquidity Crisis, and as communicated by the Chef de Cabinet “All author departments will be asked to reduce the length of their reports by 10%, i.e., the wordcount of this year’s report should be at least 10% lower than the wordcount of the previous year’s report.” He explained, therefore, for this resumed session of the

Committee, the length of the report would have to be reduced by at least 10% and the reduction would impact both procedural and substantive parts of the report. He emphasized that, by working together in a spirit of consensus, the Committee would be able to hold a successful and productive session.

34. The representative of India extended his delegation's compliments to the NGO Branch for the successful completion of the regular session in January and February 2025 that granted consultative status to 119 new NGOs and 29 deferred NGOs. He underscored that the session was held in a professional and transparent manner and that it was noteworthy that the NGO Branch had for the first time shared a list of NGOs who have expressed their interest in attending the proceedings. He emphasized that, as in the past, his delegation would extend full support to the NGO Branch and work with Committee colleagues to ensure that the resumed session concluded successfully and satisfactorily. He added that India had an active, vibrant and pluralistic civil society and his delegation supported an inclusive approach with regard to the participation of civil society in the relevant work of the United Nations. He added that his delegation fully realised the critical role of the Committee on NGOs, as an inter-governmental, specialised body, under ECOSOC. The guidelines and processes were well outlined in resolution 1996/31 to assess the credibility of all applications, seek clarifications to enable it to make a well-considered recommendation to the ECOSOC. He stressed that his delegation was confident that in this session the Committee would be able to uphold the inter-governmental nature of decisions taken by this specialized body to its fullest. He mentioned that his delegation would continue to support the established procedures and practices of this Committee and committed to working with other delegations towards achieving this cause.

35. The representative of Türkiye noted that the significant role and influence of civil society was growing. He stressed that NGOs played important supporting functions in local, national, regional and global development processes. The participation of the civil society helped promote local ownership, civic engagement and accountability and the NGO Committee had a crucial role to facilitate and improve the cooperation between the UN and civil society which contributed to the sustainability and effectiveness of UN efforts in their areas of work. He expressed appreciation for the contributions of the NGOs in consultative status to the work of the UN. He added that as long as their objectives and activities were in line with the principles and purpose of the UN Charter and ECOSOC resolution 1996/31, Türkiye continued to support the active participation of NGOs in the work of ECOSOC and its subsidiary bodies as well as in the international conferences organized by the UN. He stressed that Türkiye would continue to support the granting of consultative status in conformity with the purposes and principles of the United Nations Charter as well as the framework set by resolution 1996/31. He emphasized that the Committee's mandate was clear. Resolution 1996/31 provided the Committee with a solid basis to conduct its work. He reiterated that the role and competence of the NGO Committee should not be undermined as the primary specialized UN body to consider consultative status applications. He also mentioned that the Committee should be able to maintain its regular working method of reviewing each application on a case-by-case basis. He stressed that bypassing the Committee's usual review process in order to selectively grant certain organizations consultative status was counterproductive and against the mandate given to the Committee by ECOSOC. He noted that the review of the applications as well as the quadrennial reports were very critical to ensure the compliance of the NGOs with the principles and purpose of the UN Charter as well as resolution 1996/31. He underscored that one important task of the Committee was to implement the provisions of resolution 1996/31 and monitor the consultative relationship. He reiterated Türkiye's continued commitment to the valuable work of the Committee.

---

36. The representative of China thanked the Chair and NGO Branch for the efforts in preparing for this session and assured the Committee that China will work actively and constructively with all parties to finish all the established agenda items and ensure the success of the session. She noted that NGOs played an important role in assisting the work of the United Nations. She emphasized that the Committee on NGOs was the main body for the consideration of the consultative relationship between NGOs and ECOSOC. She said as a responsible member of the Committee, following the principles of professionalism, impartiality and objectivity, China had carefully considered every application for consultative status to support the orderly participation of eligible NGOs in the work of the UN. She stated that during this year's session the Committee had efficiently processed the large number of applications and quadrennial reports and successfully completed the established agenda which demonstrated the effectiveness of its current working methods. She stressed that China supported improving the Committee's working methods, but the aim should not be to lower the standards for NGOs applying for status, but rather to make the deliberations more efficient and professional. She added that no matter how the working methods were adjusted, the principle of decision making by consensus should not be changed, nor should the Committee's authority in granting consultative status. She underscored that in recent years a certain member of the Committee had repeatedly posed difficult questions to organizations from China and other developing countries, it had even attacked other members in the name of supporting NGOs. She stressed that this was a blatant double standard and politicization. She added that on the one hand, the member concerned ignoring the active and thorough responses already given by Chinese organizations, repeatedly asked the same questions and even made preconceived assumptions about the nature of the organizations in question. On the other hand, she stressed that this member had pushed for granting consultative status to some organizations based on its own preferences. She mentioned that China firmly opposed this practice and advised the country concerned to be more professional and dedicated and to earnestly fulfill its obligations as a member of the Committee and to carry out the work objectively and impartially. She emphasized that as this year marked the 80th anniversary of the UN, many processes were going on, and to ensure the completion of the agenda, China did not propose to have discussions on working methods in the informal working group in the short term. She stated that subsequent discussions and adjustments to the working methods of the Committee should be based on consensus among all members and be carried out in strict compliance with the relevant rules and regulations of the UN with regard for operational realities and the concerns of organizations from developing countries to ensure the authority of the Committee and the effectiveness of its work. She said China appreciated the efforts by the NGO Branch to actively implement its mandate and coordinate the work of the Committee in spite of many difficulties. She expressed hope that all members of the Committee would rise above political interference and enhance efficiency of the Committee's work to complete the deliberations of this resumed session, create better conditions for the participation of NGOs in the activities of the UN and contribute to upholding the authority of the Committee and the central role of the UN.

37. The representative of the United Kingdom stated that, as the Committee continued its important work in this session, the United Kingdom remained committed to its effective, fair and transparent functioning. By doing so, the United Kingdom was championing civil society participation in the UN. She emphasized that civil society played a critical role in tackling global issues from climate change to conflict, while holding those in power to account. She mentioned that with civil society's vital perspectives and evidence, more informed decisions could be made to achieve a more equitable and just future. She underscored, however, that politicised deferrals and repeated questions continued to obstruct civil society access to the UN.

She added that this had led to ever-worsening backlogs and bureaucratic delays, even when questions were answered transparently and in detail, which compounded pressures within the existing liquidity crisis. She noted that during this session, the Committee will review 356 deferred applications, alongside 258 new applications. This pattern of arbitrary blocking over such a sustained period was in contradiction to the spirit of ECOSOC resolution 1996/31, which aimed to foster meaningful collaboration between NGOs and the UN Member States. She added the United Kingdom intended to seek approval of all applications from all legitimate NGOs. Scrutiny of NGOs will be only on the following categories in line with 1996/31: (i) The NGO must exist and be currently active; (ii) The NGO is independent of government, with a majority of positions filled by individuals without government connection; (iii) The NGO does not cause harm to people, property, or the environment; and (iv) The NGO and its staff are in adherence to the UN Charter, in that it does not engage in politically motivated attacks against Member States, nor verifiably benefit from proceeds of criminal activity. She emphasized that the United Kingdom encouraged all Committee Members to use a fair and objective review process. She stressed that such a commitment would foster more meaningful civil society engagement at the UN while improving the efficiency of the Committee's work. She also mentioned the United Kingdom recognised that continued reform of the Committee's methods was also necessary, and the United Kingdom remained supportive of efforts to achieve this, including within the informal working group. She urged all Committee Members to promote and facilitate a safe and welcoming space for civil society participation at the UN.

38. The representative of Israel stated that civil society played an important role in the international arena. She underscored that the contributions provided by non-governmental organizations enriched the discussions, provided important data and facilitated voices from across the globe. She said these discussions helped better understand the needs of various groups, gave a voice to those unheard and enabled Member States to reach better outcomes, acknowledging global and local trends. She emphasized that it was through the lenses of NGOs that challenges at hand could be better understood, and adequate responses were provided to tackle them. She underscored that through its membership in the Committee on NGOs, Israel strove to create an inclusive space for NGOs at the UN. She also added that Israel collaborated with various NGOs on a regular basis in the context of UN activities in many focus areas, including through co-sponsorship of side events, receiving expert input, conducting research and more. She stressed that the NGO arena must be a space for constructive action and not a platform for those who exploited our openness to spread incitement, promote division, or support violence in any form. Regarding the need to cut 10% of the report, she asked if this would be done with due consideration of the fact that the report was fairly technical and also relied on reflecting the complete list of NGOs being discussed. She asked how the substance of the deliberations would be reflected in the report while not reducing its technical content.

39. The representative of Cuba stated that Cuba was convinced of the utility and benefits of the participation of civil society in the work of the United Nations. He underscored that for decades thousands of NGOs among the many from the Global South and many from Cuba had made a significant contribution to the work of the United Nations in line with the procedures and established practices, including the consultative status with ECOSOC. He said Cuba was convinced of the cardinal importance that this Committee had in the careful analysis of requests for consultative status. He added that Cuba was committed to continue participating in this Committee and it was important for NGOs to contribute with their expertise and their contributions from the ground so that they could enrich the intergovernmental discussions that took place within the framework of the United Nations. He stressed that it was also important that the NGO participation should not contribute to the

politicization of the work of the organization. He mentioned that as a member of the Committee, Cuba invited NGOs that were interested in requesting consultative status, in line with the provisions of resolution 1996/31, to continue making their valuable contributions to the work of the United Nations. He stated that Cuba attaches a great importance to the informal working group on working methods. He emphasizes however, that for small delegations it could be a challenge to be able to attend if it is convened in parallel with other UN meetings. He asked in that regard, if the secretariat, when convening the informal working group, could take into account other processes of ECOSOC and its subsidiary bodies to avoid overlapping meetings.

40. The representative of China inquired if the 10% reduction of the report was in comparison to the report of the regular or the resumed session. He also asked how quickly responses of NGOs to questions posed by Committee members would be uploaded in the paperless system. The Vice-Chair clarified that the reduction of the report of the current session was based on the word count of the report of last year's resumed session of the Committee. The Chief of the NGO Branch explained that responses by NGOs would be uploaded in the paperless system as quickly as possible to allow NGOs to respond by the deadline of 27 May at 3 pm.

41. In his closing remarks, at the 25th meeting, on 29 May 2025, the Vice-Chair highlighted the good-spirited and constructive tone of discussions during the session, which re-affirmed the Committee's shared commitment to improving the efficiency and fairness of the Committee's work. This session marked a significant undertaking, during which the Committee recommended a total of 170 organizations for consultative status, representing 31% of all applications under review. This included 57% of new applications and 8% of deferred applications. He expressed his appreciation to the NGOs that submitted timely written responses to the Committee's questions, and to those who participated in person during the interactive Q&A sessions saying that their candid and constructive engagement had been vital to the work of the Committee. He added that NGOs continued to play a vital role in the work of the United Nations, helping to amplify the voice of marginalized communities and bringing valuable expertise and perspectives to the Committee's deliberations. He stressed that, despite the continuing liquidity crisis and the reduction in the number of meetings, the Committee had remained productive and constructive, by reviewing more new applications this session than in previous ones. He thanked the committee members by saying that this achievement reflected the full commitment and collaborative spirit of all Committee members. He also commended the NGO Branch and the Secretariat for their exceptional professionalism and dedication mentioning their tireless efforts in managing the increased volume of applications and quadrennial reports, and in supporting both Committee members and NGOs, were instrumental in facilitating the Committee's work. He also raised his concern regarding the deepening resource constraints facing the NGO Branch. He stressed that as the Chief of the Branch had emphasized in his opening remarks, these limitations posed significant risks to the Branch's ability to fulfill its responsibilities under ECOSOC resolution 1996/31. And he urged that, without full support, the delivery and efficiency of future sessions may be adversely impacted. He encouraged all regional groups to consider stepping forward to ensure a fully constituted Bureau ahead of the next Session of the Committee. As the informal working group would begin discussions on further refining our working methods, he was confident that even greater improvements could be achieved. He announced that he would soon suggest a few dates, carefully chosen to avoid overlap with other Committee sessions, for a start-up meeting of the working group. He thanked Committee members for the strong support, collaboration, and commitment.

## **B. Attendance**

42. The session was attended by 18 members of the Committee. Observers for other States Members of the United Nations, observers for non-member States and representatives of organizations of the United Nations system and NGOs also attended. The list of participants will be issued in document E/C.2/2025/INF/2.

43. At its 2025 resumed session, the Committee heard eight representatives of NGOs, who were given the opportunity to respond to questions raised by the Committee.

## **C. Election of officers**

44. No Bureau members were elected in the resumed session.

## **D. Agenda**

## **IX. Adoption of the report of the Committee on its 2025 resumed session**

46. At its 25th meeting on 29 May, the Committee took note of the draft report and authorized the Vice-Chair to finalize the report with the support of the Secretariat and in consultation with the members of the Committee, as appropriate, with a view to its submission to the Economic and Social Council for appropriate action.

47. At its 26th meeting on 5 June, the Committee adopted the present report.
