



III. ECLAC's platforms and tools to advance the SDGs

The anual Forum of the Countries of Latin America and the Caribbean on Sustainable Development brings together governments, civil society, the private sector, ECLAC's subsidiary bodies, development banks, other UN agencies and regional integration blocs to accelerate action for the SDGs.



ECLAC's Community of Practice on Voluntary National Reviews

Informal mechanism for exchange among peers and sharing of good practices and lessons learned between Latin American and Caribbean countries on the implementation of the 2030 Agenda and the VNR process, with 65 virtual sessions over the timeframe of 5 years.





ECLAC launched a guide to support the efforts of local governments to territorialize the 2030 Agenda through the preparation of voluntary local reviews (VLRs). The guide is based on the review of 85 VLRs in 67 localities in 11 LAC countries.
