The Forum has universal membership and promotes the management, conservation and sustainable development of all types of forests and strengthens long-term political commitment to this end.

19th session of the Forum (UNFF19, May 2024)

UNFF19 undertook its midterm review of the International Arrangement on Forests and charted the course towards 2030. Key outcome documents of the session were its high-level declaration and omnibus resolution, containing a set of actions to accelerate progress towards towards the Global Forest Goals of the UN Strategic Plan for Forests 2030, including through the adoption of the UNFF's Quadrennial Programme of Work for 2025-2028.

20th session of the Forum (UNFF20, May 2025)

UNFF20 will hold technical discussions on the implementation of the UN Strategic Plan for Forests 2030 with a focus on Global Forest Goals 1, 3 and 5 as its thematic priorities. These discussions will include an interactive exchange of experiences and lessons learned on thematic priorities among UNFF Members, the Collaborative Partnership on Forests and its members, regional/subregional and Major Group partners and stakeholders, science-policy interface, and cross-sectoral and emerging issues.

UN Strategic Plan for Forests and the Global Forest Goals

The UN Strategic Plan for Forests 2030 (A/RES/71/285) features six Global Forest Goals and 26 targets to sustainably manage all types of forests and trees, halt deforestation and forest degradation, as well as increase forest area by 3% by 2030. The Forum monitors progress in the implementation of the UNSPF.
