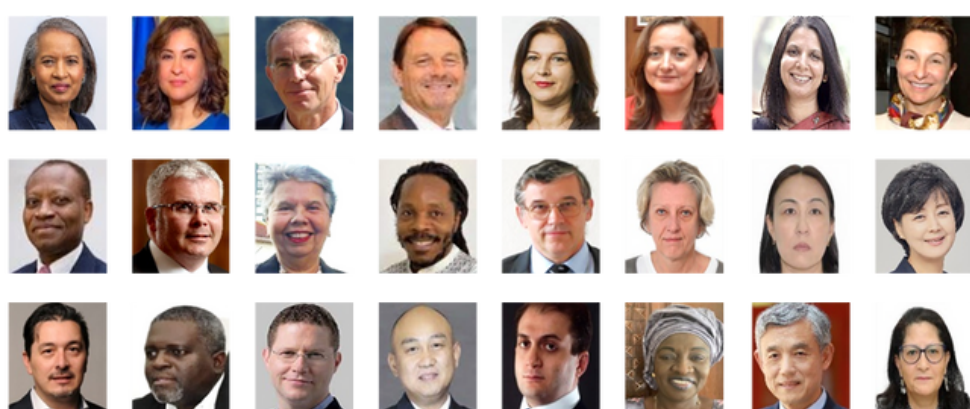

### Selected recommendations:



Address complex problems underlying crises in a holistic manner, ensuring that crisis management does not hinder progress on SDGs



Increase efforts to support national and international peer exchanges on building strong institutions for SDG implementation

Build inclusive institutions at all levels through holistic, people-centred policies and interventions that leave no one behind



Promote professionalization and diversity of the public sector workforce to support implementation of 2030 Agenda



Increase the collaboration between governments and the insurance industry to better mitigate climate change risks



Promote sound public financial management to reinforce sustainable development and build trust in public institutions

Apply principles of effective governance for sustainable development to public institutions at all levels



Identify principles and priorities for the use of artificial intelligence by the public sector to secure benefits and mitigate risks
