Adopted a historic resolution to incrementally increase membership from 24 to 54 members over the next three years, enhancing representation and inclusivity within the Commission.



FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES OF OFFICIAL STATISTICS

Celebrated the 30th anniversary of the Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics, emphasizing their critical role in producing reliable data in a changing data ecosystem.

UPDATE OF THE SYSTEM OF NATIONAL ACCOUNTS

Endorsed recommendations for updating the 2008 System of National Accounts, excluding marketing assets, while expressing readiness to support the political process defining "Beyond GDP" measurements.

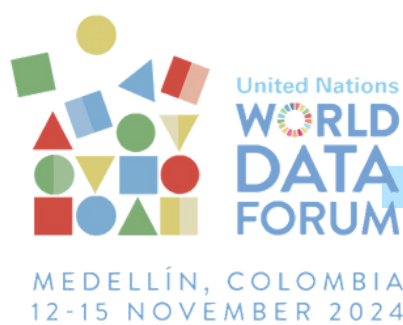


SDG INDICATOR METHODOLOGIES

DATA GOVERNANCE SEMINAR

Discussed data governance with suggestions for its integration into the Commission to support national statistical systems.



5th UN WORLD DATA FORUM, MEDELLÍN

Invited all data stakeholders to participate in the UN World Data Forum in November 2024 in Colombia, where the renewed Cape Town Global Action Plan for Sustainable Development Data will be highlighted.
